The Martial Arts Charitable Trust (MACT) was established in 2013 with the purpose of helping students in martial arts who, in the absence of financial support, would be unable to continue with their training.

Since then, MACT has provided over 5,000 hours of free lessons and:

• Supported 16 young students from MAFI (Martial Arts Federation International) affiliated clubs paying for over 2000 karate lessons which have resulted in 32 successful gradings.

Five of these students have participated in regional and international martial arts competitions

- Provided funding for karate equipment and lessons at Carlton Primary School in Camden where 20 + children participate in our classes at no cost (since 2015)
- Awarded a teaching scholarship to a senior MAFI student to further their development in Martial Arts by becoming an assistant teacher helping to train younger students.
- Sponsoring athletes for travel costs in Kickboxing and Karate for various regional and national championships who would not have been able to take part without financial assistance.

The feedback from the schools, both in terms of the enjoyment derived by the children and in their observed behavioural patterns have been extremely encouraging.

To date, financing of our activities has been made possible through the proceeds of MACT fund raising events. However, we have made significant commitments and our funds are not everlasting, in order for MACT to continue and expand its activities we are in urgent need of additional funding and support.
